

Ottawa County Barn Quilt Trail

Information for barn/building/property owners

The Ottawa County 4-H Program and the Greater Port Clinton Area Arts Council would like to thank you for your support of the Ottawa County Barn Quilt Trail by providing a location for a quilt square.

***Timeline** – The approximate timeline for the project is targeted for five+ years after the last block is hung/mounted. If maintenance is needed for the block we will address concerns to the best of our ability. The project will be constantly reviewed during the five years and comments and suggestions will be accepted.

***Mounting** - Squares will be mounted directly to barns/buildings in an easily viewable location. An attached document describes the mounting process. Please note, if for any reason the block is removed from you barn/building, we will seal any holes in your building and/or replace landscaping where block was mounted.

***Brochures and Visitors** – Colorful informational brochures will be produced and a Facebook page will be created advertising trail locations for visitors along with sponsoring 4-H clubs or organization, individuals and businesses. Barn/building owners should expect visitors stopping in to view the block and possibly taking a photo or two.
